If the needles have been inserted correctly, the right needle should be set slightly lower than the left one. To sew fine materials 1 Adjust the presser foot to prevent the material from puckering and to allow sewing of curves. Since this machine has already been adjusted to a pressure suitable for light to medium fabrics, no further adjustment is necessary except when sewing on very heavy or very light materials. However, the following chart indicates trouble which may occur if basic adjustments are not made properly. Trouble 1. Does not feed Presser foot pressure too loose 1. Needles bent, or needle tip blunt 2. This stitch is sewn by removing the left needle and using the 3thread overlock stitch. Storage for the stitch finger is provided on the inside of the front cover illustrated. NOTE Make sure to install stitch finger when sewing regular overlock stitches. 1 Upperlooper 2 Stitch finger 3 Stitch finger release lever 4 Front cover. Set the stitch length adjustment lever to "R" position as shown in the illustration. This adjustment is suitable for either Narrow Overlock stitch or Rolled Edge stitch. To Do Rolled Edge Stitch This application rolls the edge of the fabric inside of the hem stitch. This is ideal when sewing cuffs, trouser bottoms, pockets, and hemming skirts etc. Use it to hem pants, skirts, or draperies. The finished stitch can look like a ladder or small parallel lines when the fabric is pulled flat. Either stitch finish can be used on the right side of the fabric. The following are the recommended setting. Fold the fabric on a line where the pin tuck is to be located and guide the fold through the serger. Decorative thread with a high thread count or extremely fine thread can be used in the upperlooper to produce decorative stitches to make any project more exciting. If one strand of thread can be cut off in front of or at the rear of the knife, the knife is sharp enough. When the knives are blunt, replace them as described on the next page. Always clean the lint off your machine before you apply oil. Tighten right needle thread pink.

There is one factor that bothered me and is the reason I give it a 4 Star rating. This machine needs pre oiling before you use it the first time!!! How do you know this! I found it in the reviews BEFORE I purchased it. On Page 57 it shows where the oiling needs to happen. Word of advice. DO IT! You will not regret it. I oil it about once a month or so unless Ive been taking a break from sewing. I wish this would be put in a quick guide so that if the machine is new to you, you know to oil it. Quickest way to destroy a machine. No oil! That being said, once this little work horse is oiled, it will serge like a dream. Quickly and efficient, it makes short work of quickly finishing raw edges. It has a removable arm, to sew cuffs. I love that you can adjust for the type of fabric and your stitch width. I know it has several stitch types, however I just use it for serging. I find it quick and easy to load with thread, though like most sergers, the lower feeds sometimes can be a bit tricky. For quick color changes, I simply cut the threads back behind the feeders, tie the new color on, then run it out on swatches of left over fabric, I have found this to be much faster and easier than rethreading my entire machine. At first, I was intimidated by the idea of buying a serger, but I promise its really pretty simple to use and even changing out the thread is easier than I expected. For the price, you cant beat the value. Before purchasing a serger, I used a very expensive Baby Lock Ovation at a sewing workshop. Dont be afraid to purchase a serger online. I know lots of seamstresses will suggest buying one from a local dealer to get customer service and repairs, but for such a low price you really cant go wrong. None of the Brother sewing machines Ive owned have ever needed to be serviced or have broken. While I know the serger has many functions, I have solely used it as a 4thread overlocker which is why I bought it in the first place. I find it to be a bit of a hassle to constantly convert and change a sewing machine. Brother products are so affordable and I personally have found the quality to be great especially when considering the price. Adding the Brother 1034D Serger to my sewing machine arsenal has been one of my most useful purchases. Some tips I can offer to help avoid frustration Always test out scrap fabrics that are the same as the project youre working on The different settings including differential feed, stitch length, and stitch width play around with them

using scraps and keep a notebook handy to record which settings worked best with various fabrics as a reference guide. Make sure the presser foot is down before you start to serge; this may seem kind of common sense, but I've accidentally serged with the presser foot up more times than I'd like to admit! Then the prongs just popped off the needle plate, no pins, no extraordinary amounts of fabric, just popped off in the middle of a seam. I couldn't get a hold of Brother, since I was working during the only times the call center was open, so I just bought a new needle plate, from a Brother authorized parts dealer.

In the picture attached, you can see there's a slight difference in the size of the hole on the new plate vs the old plate. Those few millimeters, though, make the entire machine inoperable, because it means that instead of the needle passing just in front of the needle guard that screws into the bottom of the needle plate, into the hole in question, the needle hits the needle guard. Brother's reaction: I'd have to take it to the nearest authorized service center 140 miles away. Or I can try buying the parts from them, spending still more money, because the only way they'll agree to the problem being a manufacturing defect is if the authorized service center says so. So, yeah, before you consider giving the Brother company any of your money, check where the nearest service center is, or be prepared to have your money be wasted. Should have realized after the 2nd time I used it and the arm bar handle flew off that mine was a lemon. Tension dials became loose actual little bolts, causing constant timing issues once trying to stitch. Needless to say I am buying another brand. Since this is said to be one of the hardest parts of serging I really appreciate this touch. Comes with an extra set of needles. I can't claim any great expertise, but this is a great machine. It is simple to operate and, most importantly, to thread, as this seems to be the biggest problem most people have. It comes with a very clear operating manual which covers all the important points and, even better, a DVD which actually demonstrates how it all works. Early days for me, but so far, I have managed to successfully accomplish basic sewing and have easily rethreaded the machine. It has a lot of features which are going to be very useful as I gain experience. I am not currently using it to its full potential, but that is down to my limitations, not those of the machine. I would recommend this overlocker to anyone who wants a foolproof basic machine. Sorry, we failed to record your vote.

It arrived quickly however I didn't open it and try it out for almost a month as I wasn't expecting any problems with it. When I ran it the first time, it made a terrible sound of grinding metal. Having read online reviews saying this was a noisy machine, I wondered if this was normal. I tried it a few more times and always had the same grinding noise on start up, but

then it smoothed out after a few seconds. I took video of the machine running and showed it to a technician at a sewing machine repair shop and they confirmed it is definitely NOT a normal sound.

By this time, I was a week past the normal return window. I contacted Amazon Customer service and was immediately connected with a rep Don who got approval to return the faulty machine at no cost to me.
